

Ruby Hall Memorial Scholarship Application Instructions

1. Applications **must** be typewritten.
2. Applications **must** be given to **Mrs. Folker** in the high school office **no later than March 3, 2017**. **All reviews and corrections must be made by this date.** *(If school is cancelled for any reason on the day of the scholarship deadlines, the applications will be due at 3:30 the first day back in session after the original deadline date.)* Failure to make the deadline for submission (March 4) will make students ineligible for the general scholarships. **STUDENTS MUST TURN IN THEIR APPLICATIONS BY 3:30 ON March 3, 2017.** (No exceptions)
3. Following processing by the Gentry High School staff as described herein, completed applications **must** be mailed to: Curtis Hall, 1602 Riverridge Rd, Lawrence, KS 66044 or emailed to hallcd@sbcglobal.net to arrive not later than April 10th.
4. Applications should be free of errors.
5. Attach to the application a 200 - 300 word essay listing and explaining past involvement in character-building activities and short, mid and long term goals.
6. Applications should include an appropriate photo – no glamour shots, please. (Preferably a wallet size. These will **not** be returned.)
7. The following information must be obtained from your high school counselor and entered on or included with the application.
 - A copy of your high school transcript
 - An official copy of your ACT scores including the composite score. (If you have not taken the ACT, please specify.)
 - Grade Point Average (GPA).
 - Class Rank.

GPA and Class Rank should reflect your completion of the 7th semester.

8. Only completed applications submitted in the following order will be considered for funding.

Applications should be stapled in the upper left-hand corner.

- 3) transcript and ACT scores

***All questions should be answered. If a question is not applicable, blanks should be filled with N/A.**
